**All Night Adoration.** From after the ceremony, until 6:00 a.m.

Liturgical Action **In Passione Domini.**

The Communion fast should be kept from 1:30 p.m.

After the Ceremony:

**The Exercise of the Seven Words.**

"The faithful who between three o'clock on the afternoon of Good Friday and noon of the following day, spend some time in devout meditation or offer some prayers, either in public or in private, in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary sorrowing, may gain a plenary indulgence on the usual conditions."
